RESOLUTION NO. 1765
ESTABLISHING A PORTION OF CHERRY CREEK ROAD
AS A COUNTY HIGHWAY

This matter coming on to be heard before the Board of Supervisors of Yavapai County, Arizona, on April 4, 2011, pursuant to legal notice thereof, at the request of the County Engineer and the petition filed with the Board of Supervisors, and the Board determining that the establishment of the following road as a County highway is a public necessity, having fully considered the feasibility, advantages, and necessity of its establishment:

Cherry Creek Road as shown on a map on file in the office of the Yavapai County Engineer, beginning approximately 1450 feet North of the South line of Section 30, Township 14 North, Range 3 East, thence Southerly, thence Southwesterly, thence Southerly through Sections 30 and 31, Township 14 North, Range 3 East and Sections 1 and 12, Township 13 North, Range 2 East to its intersection with State Route 169.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Yavapai County, Arizona, that the above described road, and as shown on the attached Exhibit "A", be designated and established forthwith as a County highway.
