RESOLUTION NO. 1767

ESTABLISHING A PORTION OF THUMB BUTTE/DEARING ROAD AS A COUNTY HIGHWAY

This matter coming on to be heard before the Board of Supervisors of Yavapai County, Arizona, on May 2, 2011, pursuant to legal notice thereof, at the request of the County Engineer and the petition filed with the Board of Supervisors, and the Board determining that the establishment of the following road as a County highway is a public necessity, having fully considered the feasibility, advantages, and necessity of their establishment:

THUMB BUTTE ROAD/DEARING ROAD beginning at the East subdivision line of Dearing Park Unit 3, as recorded in Book 16, Page 53, of Maps & Plats, and located in Section 3, T13N, R3W, thence through U.S. Forest Service land easterly and northeasterly to its intersection with Camp Willow Springs Road in Section 35, T14N, R3W and as shown on Exhibit "A".

All above stated recorded documents are on record at the office of the Yavapai County Recorder, Prescott, Arizona.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Yavapai County, Arizona, that the above described road, and as shown on the attached Exhibit "A", be designated and established forthwith as a County highway.
