ADOPTION OF OWNER OCCUPIED HOUSING REHABILITATION GUIDELINES

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF YAVAPAI COUNTY
AUTHORIZING THE ADOPTION OF EMERGENCY HOUSING REPAIR GUIDELINES
DATED MAY 2012 IN RELATION TO AN APPLICATION FOR FY 2012 STATE SPECIAL
PROJECTS COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) FUNDS AND/OR
AN APPLICATION FOR 2013 REGIONAL ACCOUNT CDBG FUNDS.

WHEREAS, Yavapai County is desirous of undertaking owner-occupied housing
emergency repair activities; and

WHEREAS, this program is anticipated to be funded with Community Development
Block Grant funds provided by the State of Arizona, and

WHEREAS, the Arizona Department of Housing requires that every entity requesting
funds for emergency housing repairs adopt specific guidelines for such a program; and

WHEREAS, NACOG has developed such emergency housing repair guidelines (EHRGs)
for the County, dated May 2012;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT YAVAPAI COUNTY hereby adopts
such EHRGs, dated May 2012, which shall be used to implement its CDBG-funded emergency
housing repair program funded through its application for FY 2012 funds, and

THAT, Yavapai County shall utilize such EHRGs, without revisions, except such
authorized by the chief elected official or a person authorized in writing to approve such revisions
via the Program's CD-1 Form; with such revisions submitted to the CDBG Program within a
maximum of 10 working days of authorization.
