

RESOLUTION NO. 1810

A RESOLUTION OF THE YAVAPAI COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS AUTHORIZING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A HOME DETENTION/CONTINUOUS ALCOHOL MONITORING PROGRAM AND HOME DETENTION PROGRAM

WHEREAS, The Yavapai County Board of Supervisors (the "Board") may, pursuant to ARS § 11-251.15(H) establish a home detention/continuous alcohol monitoring program for a persons who are sentenced to jail confinement pursuant to section 28-1381 or 28-1382; as well as establish a home detention program for eligible sentenced prisoners for other charges pursuant to ARS § 11-251.15(A) and

WHEREAS, the Board has after a public hearing and making a finding of necessity; and

WHEREAS, the Presiding Justice of the Peace of the Yavapai County Justice Courts shall approve the program before its implementation.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE YAVAPAI COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS hereby establishes a home detention/continuous alcohol monitoring program and a home detention program for eligible sentenced prisoners which shall be treated the same as confinement in jail pursuant to ARS § 11-251.15(H) and ARS § 11-251.15(A), and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Yavapai County Courts may prepare an RFP and enter into a contract with vendor(s) to provide this service at no cost to the county.
