RESOLUTION NO. 1823

**ESTABLISHING A PORTION OF CHERRY CREEK ROAD
AS A COUNTY HIGHWAY**

This matter coming on to be heard before the Board of Supervisors of Yavapai County, Arizona, on March 4, 2013, pursuant to legal notice thereof, at the request of the County Engineer and the petition filed with the Board of Supervisors, and the Board determining that the establishment of the following road as a County highway is a public necessity, having fully considered the feasibility, advantages, and necessity of their establishment:

CHERRY CREEK ROAD, Beginning approximately 75 feet South of the North line of Section 31, T14N, R3E at the crossing of Hackberry Wash, then southerly to the South line of Section 31, T14N, R3E.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Yavapai County, Arizona, that the above described road, and as shown on the attached Exhibit "A", be designated and established forthwith as a County highway.
