RESOLUTION NO. 1861

A RESOLUTION CONVEYING TITLE OF EASEMENTS LOCATED NEAR FAIR STREET TO THE CITY OF PRESCOTT, ARIZONA

WHEREAS, Yavapai County recognizes the benefits to the public achieved by the creation of recreational trails and;

WHEREAS, the City of Prescott, through its City Council in 1996 adopted a trails plan for the construction and maintenance of recreational trails in and about the City of Prescott, and;

WHEREAS, Yavapai County recognizes the benefits to the public achieved by entering into Intergovernmental Agreements and transferring certain easements across land owned and possessed by Yavapai County to the City of Prescott for use as public recreation trails; and

WHEREAS, the City of Prescott, pursuant to Intergovernmental Agreements with Yavapai County, has agreed that in consideration for the transfer of said easements by Yavapai County that the City of Prescott will provide construction and maintenance of said trail easements for the use of the public for recreational purposes;

ENACTMENTS:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Yavapai County enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement for the conveyance of 15 foot-wide public trail easements, part of the Greenways Trail and described in Exhibits A through C along with the rights to construct and maintain the same, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that said easements are hereby granted to the City of Prescott pursuant to the terms and conditions of the respective Intergovernmental Agreements between the County and the City of Prescott.
