RESOLUTION NO. 1867

RESOLUTION DECLARING AN ORDER OF FIRE PROHIBITION IN YAVAPAI COUNTY

WHEREAS, there has been little precipitation since September 2013 across Yavapai County, and,

WHEREAS, scientific indicators identified by the Prescott National Forest point to the potential of extreme fire behavior, and

WHEREAS, the Emergency Management Officer has made a “Fire Emergency Determination,” and,

WHEREAS, the Emergency Management Officer has coordinated a fire ban with Federal, State, and Local agencies in the interest of the population, infrastructure, and environmental protection, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this Resolution shall constitute the order of fire prohibition. The order shall last until the Emergency Management Officer issues written determination that outdoor emergency fire conditions no longer exist, pursuant to Yavapai County Ordinance 2012-1, Section VII.
