## **RESOLUTION NO. 1893**

## CRESTLINE DRIVE EASEMENT EXTINGUISHMENT

The above matter came before the Yavapai County Board of Supervisors at its meeting on November 3 2014, at the request of the County Engineer to rescind the acceptance of dedication of a road known as Crestline Drive and extinguish any easements rights granted thereby, as depicted in the document recorded at Book 26 of Maps, Page 61, Official Records of Yavapai County, pursuant to A.R.S. §28-7214, and as further described on the attached Exhibit A.

The County Engineer has recommended rescinding the acceptance of dedication of said easement for Crestline Drive. The Board of Supervisors determined that the extinguishment of said easement will not leave any property without access to public roads and streets of Yavapai County, and is no longer necessary for public use, and the same should be granted.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**: (1) that the request for rescission of acceptance and extinguishment of the easement for Crestline Drive, as described above, pursuant to A.R.S. §28-7214, be approved; (2) that rights of way or easements of existing sewer, gas, water or similar pipelines and appurtenances and for canals, laterals or ditches and appurtenances, and for electric, telephone, similar lines and appurtenances shall continue as they existed prior to the disposal or extinguishment thereof; and (3) that this resolution shall take effect when it is recorded in the office of the Yavapai County Recorder.
