RESOLUTION NO. 1911

ORDER OF DISSOLUTION OF THE GRANITE GARDENS SANITARY DISTRICT

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors for the Granite Gardens Sanitary District has found that the District has no current indebtedness and that the District has no future purpose; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Granite Gardens Sanitary District, pursuant to A.R.S. §48-264 (A) has recommended the district be dissolved; and

WHEREAS, A.R.S. 48-2028 ((B) States that upon dissolution of a sanitary district the property of the district which is located within the corporate limits of a city or town shall vest in that city or town. Other property of the district shall vest in the county; and

WHEREAS, A.R.S. 48-2028 (B) States that any funds of the district at the time of dissolution shall be transferred to the incorporated city or town and to the county in proportion to the assessed valuation of taxable real property within the city or town and within the county, respectively as it appears on the current assessment roll and,

WHEREAS, the Yavapai County Board of Supervisors finds that there is no property of the district located within the county.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Yavapai County Board of Supervisors shall transfer the remaining funds of the Granite Gardens Sanitary District to the City of Prescott and that the Granite Gardens Sanitary District is dissolved.
