RESOLUTION NO. 1923

ESTABLISHING SEVERAL ROADS AS COUNTY HIGHWAYS

WHEREAS. the above matter came before the Yavapai County Board of Supervisors at its meeting on October 19, 2015, pursuant to legal notice thereof, at the request of the County Engineer and the petition filed with the Board of Supervisors, and the Board determining that the establishment of the following roads as a County highways is a public necessity, having fully considered the feasibility, advantages, and necessity of their establishment:

1. ROJO DR. in the Village of Oak Creek, beginning at the North boundary of Rancho Rojo Estates as recorded at Book 9 of Maps, Page 60, thence northeasterly for approximately 380 feet, as shown on Exhibit "A".
2. LORD CIRCLE, Castle Canyon Mesa Unit 1, as dedicated in Book 16, Page 48 of Maps & Plats, beginning at its intersections with Princess Lane, thence easterly to its termination in a cul-de-sac, as shown on Exhibit "B".
3. KNAVE LANE, Castle Canyon Mesa Unit 1, as dedicated in Book 16, Page 48 of Maps & Plats, beginning at its intersections with Princess Lane, thence easterly to its termination in a cul-de-sac, as shown on Exhibit "B".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: (1) that the above described roads be designated and established as a County Highways; and (2) that this resolution shall take effect when it is recorded in the office of the Yavapai County Recorder.

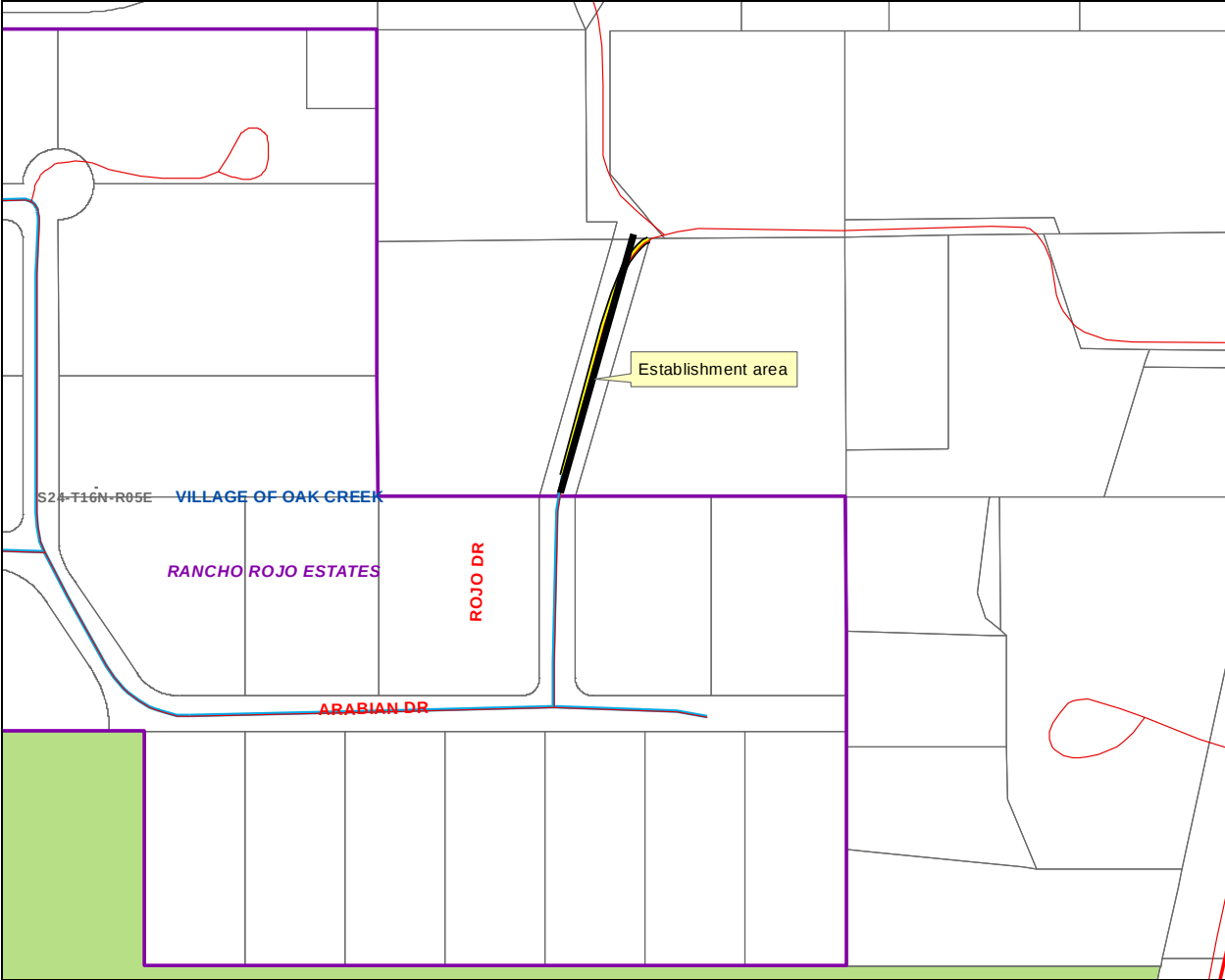

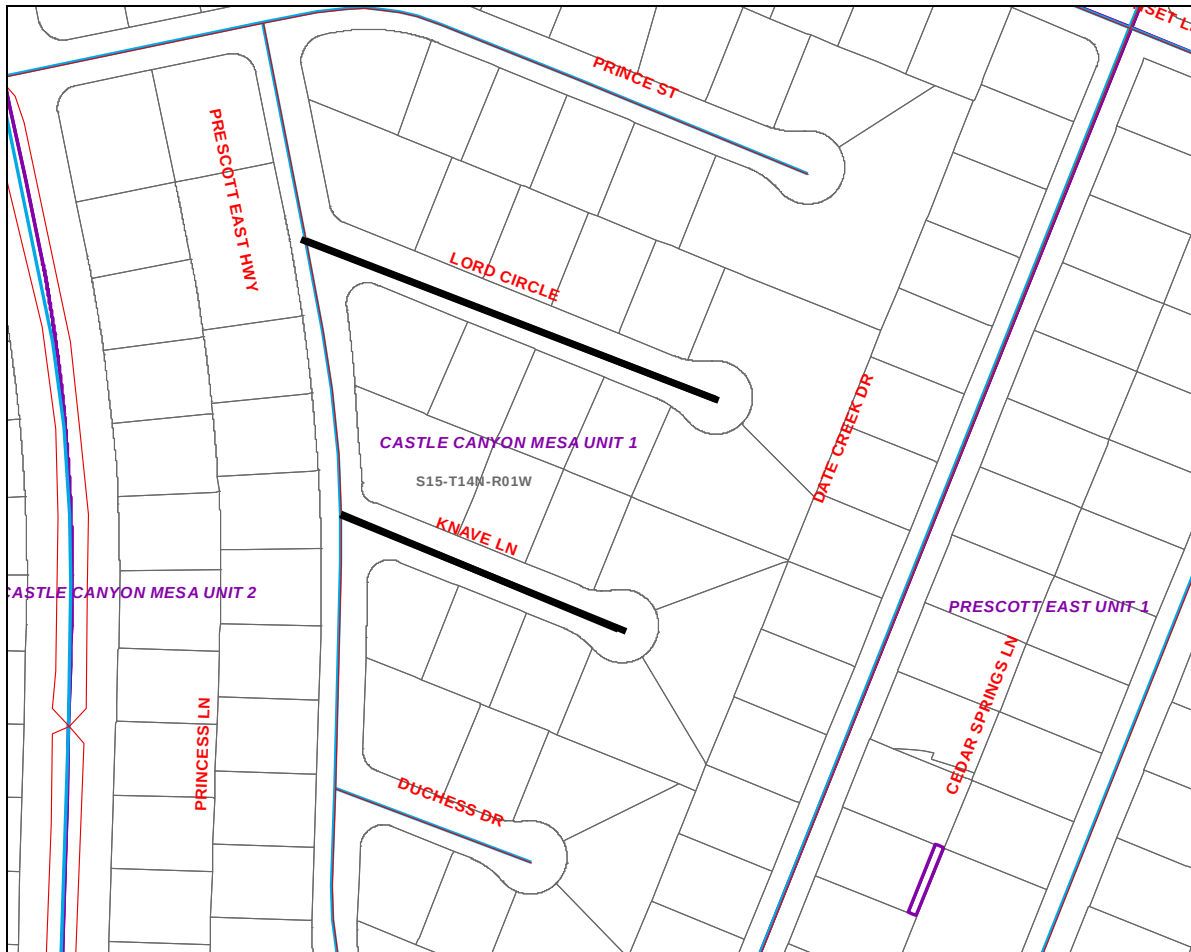
