RESOLUTION NO. 1944

**ESTABLISHING A PORTION OF FERGUSON VALLEY ROAD
AND OWL SLICK ROAD AS COUNTY HIGHWAYS**

WHEREAS. the above matter came before the Yavapai County Board of Supervisors at its meeting on June 1, 2016, pursuant to legal notice thereof, at the request of the County Engineer and the petition filed with the Board of Supervisors, and the Board determining that the establishment of the following roads as County highways is a public necessity, having fully considered the feasibility, advantages, and necessity of its establishment:

FERGUSON VALLEY ROAD, from Iron Springs Road in S28, T14N, R4W in a northerly direction to its intersection with the railroad crossing in S21, T14N, R4W, a distance of approximately 1.3 miles as shown on Exhibit "A".

OWL SLICK ROAD, from its intersection with Tissaw Loop in S20, T15N, R4E, thence South to its intersection with Vineyard View Drive as shown on Exhibit "B".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: (1) that the above described road be designated and established as a County Highway; and (2) that this resolution shall take effect when it is recorded in the office of the Yavapai County Recorder.

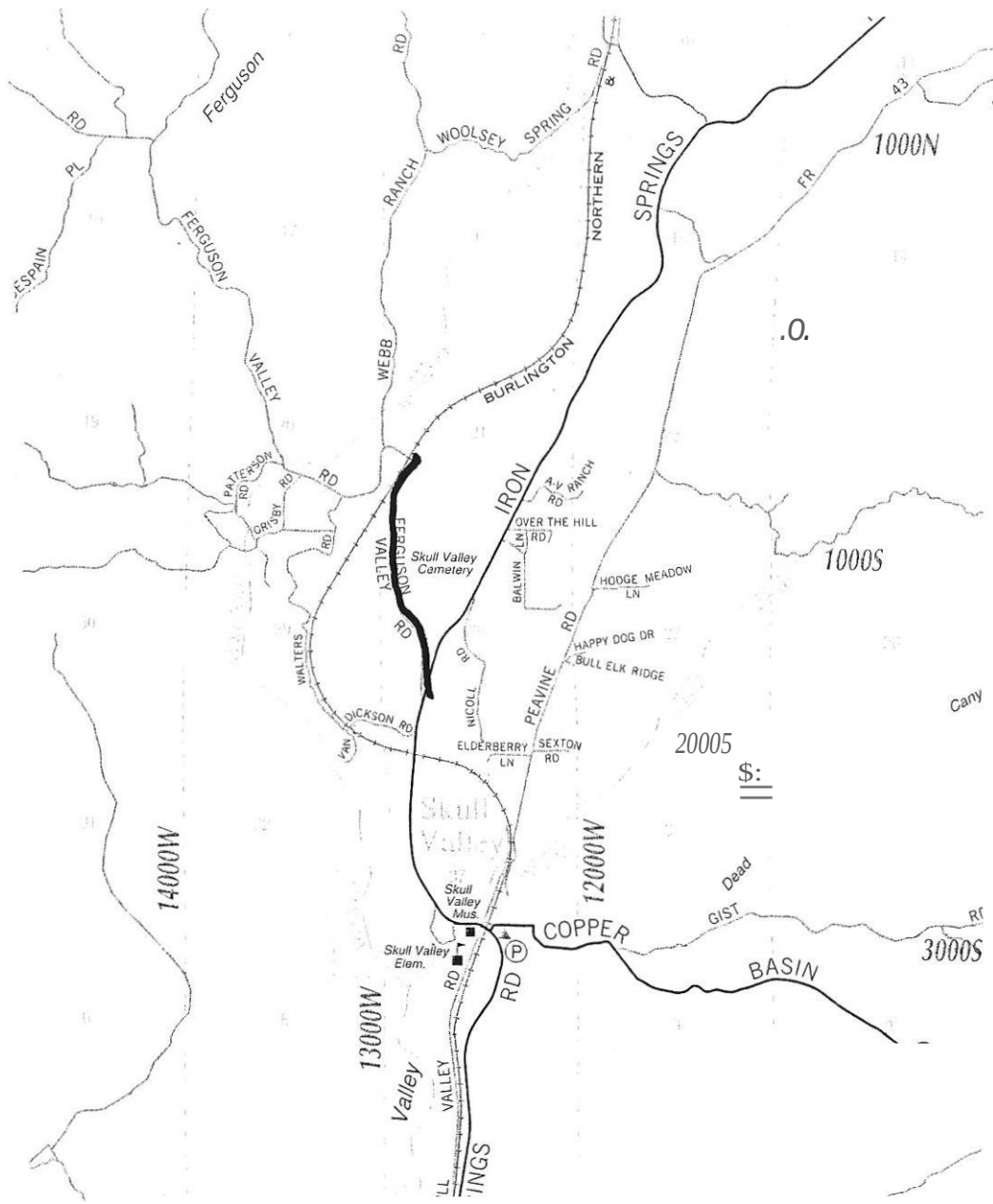
