RESOLUTION NO. 1952

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF YAVAPAI COUNTY
AUTHORIZING THE CANCELING OF ELECTIONS FOR AMERICAN
RANCH, BLACK CANYON CITY, DIAMOND VALLEY, HOLIDAY HILLS,
MYSTIC HEIGHTS, PONDEROSA PARK, QUAIL RIDGE, TIPEJI, AND
YAVAPAI RANCH DOMESTIC WATER IMPROVEMENT DISTRICTS;
CALVARY CHAPEL, HIGH VALLEY RANCH, KINGS RANCH UNIT 2,
MYSTIC HEIGHTS, AND WEAVER MOUNTAIN DOMESTIC WASTE WATER
IMPROVEMENT DISTRICTS; CENTRAL YAVAPAI HOSPITAL DISTRICT;
SHERIFF'S POSSE COMMUNITY ROAD IMPROVEMENT AND
MAINTENANCE DISTRICT; AND CREEKSIDE, INSCRIPTION CANYON
RANCH, AND IRON SPRINGS SANITARY DISTRICTS; AND APPOINTING
THE PERSONS WHO FILED NOMINATING PETITIONS**

WHEREAS, A.R.S. §48-1012(E) with regard to domestic water and waste water improvement districts; A.R.S. §48-1908(C) with regard to hospital districts; A.R.S. §48-1082(E) and A.R.S. §48-1092(E) with regard to road improvement districts; and A.R.S. §48-2010(A) with regard to sanitary districts; provide that if only one person or no person files a nominating petition for election to fill a position on the board of directors of the district, the Board of Supervisors may, by resolution, cancel the election for that office and appoint the person who filed the nominating petition to fill the position; and

WHEREAS, three positions on the board of directors for American Ranch Domestic Water Improvement District were open for election and no one filed nominating petitions; three positions on the board of directors for Black Canyon City Domestic Water Improvement District were open for election and no persons filed nominating petitions; two positions on the board of directors for Diamond Valley Water District were open for election and two persons filed nominating petitions; two positions on the board of directors for Holiday Hills Domestic Water Improvement District were open for election and no one filed nominating petitions; one position on the board of directors for Mystic Heights Domestic Water Improvement District was open for election and one person filed a nominating petition; two positions on the board of directors for Ponderosa Park Domestic Water Improvement District were open for election and no one filed nominating petitions; two positions on the board of directors for Quail Ridge Domestic Water Improvement District were open for election and two persons filed nominating petitions; one position on the board of directors for TiPeJi Domestic Water Improvement District was open for election and no one filed nominating petitions; two positions on the board of directors for Yavapai Ranch Domestic Water Improvement District was open for election and no one filed nominating petitions; and,

WHEREAS, two positions on the board of directors for Calvary Chapel Domestic Waste Water Improvement District were open for election and no one filed nominating petitions; three positions on the board of directors for High Valley Ranch Domestic Waste Water Improvement District were open for election and no one filed nominating petitions; three positions on the board of directors for Kings Ranch Unit 2 Domestic Waste Water Improvement District were open for election and no one filed nominating petitions; one position on the board of directors for Mystic Heights Domestic Waste Water Improvement District was open for election and one person filed a nominating petition; and three positions on the board of directors for Weaver Mountain Domestic Waste Water Improvement District were open for election and two persons filed nominating petitions; and,

WHEREAS, one position on the board of directors for Creekside Sanitary District was open for election and no one filed nominating petitions; two positions on the board of directors for Inscription Canyon Ranch Sanitation District were open for election and two persons filed nominating petitions; and one position on the board of directors for Iron Springs Sanitary District was open for election and one person filed a nominating petition; and

WHEREAS, two positions on the board of directors for Central Yavapai Hospital District were open for election and one person filed a nominating petition; and,

WHEREAS, two positions on the board of directors for Sheriff's Posse Community Road Improvement and Maintenance District were open for election and two persons filed nominating petitions; and

WHEREAS, each district has requested that the Board of Supervisors cancel the election and appoint the persons who filed nominating petitions.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the November 8, 2016 elections for boards of directors in American Ranch, Black Canyon City, Diamond Valley, Holiday Hills, Mystic Heights, Ponderosa Park, Quail Ridge, TiPeJi, and Yavapai Ranch Domestic Water Improvement Districts; Calvary Chapel, High Valley Ranch, Kings Ranch Unit 2, Mystic Heights, and Weaver Mountain Domestic Waste Water Improvement Districts; Central Yavapai Hospital District; Sheriff's Posse Community Road Improvement and Maintenance District; and Creekside, Inscription Canyon Ranch, and Iron Springs Sanitary Districts; are cancelled and the following persons who filed nominating petitions are appointed:

Inscription Canyon Ranch Sanitation District – David Barreira and Al Poskanzer

Iron Springs Sanitary District – George Jaeger
