RESOLUTION NO. 1977

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF YAVAPAI COUNTY AUTHORIZING THE CANCELING OF THE ELECTION FOR HIGHLAND PINES DOMESTIC WATER IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT; AND APPOINTING THE PERSONS WHO FILED NOMINATION PETITIONS OR NOMINATION PAPERS

WHEREAS, A.R.S. §48-1012(E), with regard to domestic water improvement districts, provides that if only one person or no person files a nominating petition for election to fill a position on the board of directors of the district, the Board of Supervisors may, by resolution, cancel the election for that office and appoint the person who filed the nominating petition to fill the position; and

WHEREAS, A.R.S. §16-410(A), with regard to an election that is to be held pursuant to title 48, provides that if the total of the number of persons who file a nomination petition for a candidate and the number of persons who file a nomination paper for a write-in candidate is less than or equal to the number of positions to be filled at the election for which the nomination petition or nomination paper is filed, the Board of Supervisors may cancel the election for that office no earlier than seventy-five days before the election and appoint the person or persons who filed the nomination petition or nomination paper to fill the position for the term of office for which the candidate was nominated; and

WHEREAS, two positions on the board of directors for Highland Pines Domestic Water Improvement District were open for election on March 13, 2018, and one candidate filed nominating petitions; and,

WHEREAS, the district has requested that the Board of Supervisors cancel the election and appoint the persons who filed nominating petitions.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the March 13, 2018, election for board of directors in Highland Pines Domestic Water Improvement District is cancelled and the following person who filed nominating petitions is appointed:
