A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF YAVAPAI COUNTY PERTAINING TO THE SUBMISSION AND ACCEPTANCE OF THE VERDE VALLEY FIRE DISTRICT HAVING ENTERED PHASE II OF THE GILA RIVER INDIAN COMMUNITY 2021 GRANTS CYCLE.

WHEREAS, Yavapai County Board of Supervisors encourages and supports activities that will promote public safety and services to our communities; and

WHEREAS, the Gila River Indian Community Grants Review Committee has completed its review of grant applications for the 2021 grants cycle; and

WHEREAS, the Verde Valley Fire District has prepared and submitted a grant application for consideration of the Gila River Indian Community requesting funds to be used to enhance the services they provide to the public; and

WHEREAS, the Verde Valley Fire District is being recommended for approval of funding in Phase II for a total amount of \$41,271.00

1. Verde Valley Fire District – Rural Response Vehicle. Recommended grant amount of \$41,271.00

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Yavapai County Board of Supervisors acknowledge that Phase II of the grant cycle-grant recommendation does not constitute an award; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Yavapai County Board of Supervisors will accept the grant(s) if approved, in the amount of \$41,271.00 from the Gila River Indian Community.
