RESOLUTION NO. 2097

**CANCELLING ELECTION FOR CHINO VALLEY IRRIGATION DISTRICT AND
APPOINTING THE PERSON WHO FILED NOMINATING PETITIONS**

WHEREAS, A.R.S. §16-410 provides that if the total number of persons who file a nomination petition for a candidate is less than or equal to the number of positions to be filled at the election for which the nomination petition is filed, the County Board of Supervisors may cancel the election no earlier than seventy-five days before the election and appoint the person who filed the nomination petition to fill the position for the term of office for which the candidate was nominated by the qualified electors; and

WHEREAS, one position on the board of directors for the Chino Valley Irrigation District was open for election and one person filed nomination petitions; and,

WHEREAS, the district requested that the Board of Supervisors cancel the election and appoint the person who filed nomination petitions,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the November 8, 2022, election for the Chino Valley Irrigation District is cancelled and the following person who filed nomination petitions is appointed:

Chino Valley Irrigation District – Dale Hill

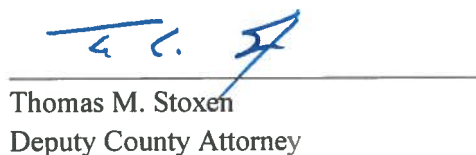
