**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF YAVAPAI COUNTY, ARIZONA FOR A PERMANENT ADJUSTMENT OF THE COUNTY'S 1979-1980 BASE EXPENDITURE LIMIT**


**WHEREAS**, the Arizona State Constitution allows the County, upon affirmative vote of at least two-thirds of the members of the governing board and approval by a majority of qualified electors at a regularly scheduled general election, to permanently adjust the County's base expenditure limit; and

**WHEREAS**, a permanent adjustment of the County's expenditure limitation will enable the County to address community needs related to public health, safety, and welfare; and

**WHEREAS**, the Yavapai County Board of Supervisors has determined that a permanent adjustment of the County's expenditure limitation is necessary for Yavapai County.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Yavapai County Board of Supervisors approves submitting to the voters of Yavapai County at the general election to be held on November 5, 2024, the question of a permanent adjustment of the County's 1979-1980 base expenditure limit increasing it by \$7,900,000. The adjustment of the base limit shall be used in determining Yavapai County's expenditure limitation beginning with the fiscal year immediately following approval.
