RESOLUTION NO. 2124

EXTINGUISHMENT OF A PORTION OF THE E. EMPIRE ROAD RIGHT-OF-WAY

WHEREAS the above matter came before the Yavapai County Board of Supervisors at its meeting on March 6, 2024, at the request of Gene B. Tolle and Patti L. Tolle for Extinguishment of a portion of the E. Empire Road right-of-way, Yavapai County, Arizona; and,

WHEREAS the County Engineer has submitted a report recommending Extinguishment of the right-of-way; and,

WHEREAS adequate notice to the public of the proposed Extinguishment was given by posting, publication, and certified mail; and,

WHEREAS the Extinguishment of the right-of-way will not leave any property without access to the public roads and streets of Yavapai County and the right-of-way is no longer necessary for public use;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:


- (1) that the request for Extinguishment of a portion of the E. Empire Road right-of-way, Yavapai County, Arizona, as shown on Exhibit A, is granted;
- (2) that rights-of-way or easements for existing sewer, gas, water or similar pipelines and appurtenances and for canals, laterals or ditches and appurtenances, and for electric, telephone, and similar lines and appurtenances shall continue as they existed prior to this Extinguishment of the public roadway easement;
- (3) that no consideration is required pursuant to A.R.S. §28-7208 and A.R.S. §28-7214 because only an easement is being extinguished and no title is being transferred; and,
- (4) that this Resolution shall take effect when it and an Extinguishment Plat provided by the Tolle's, are recorded in the office of the Yavapai County Recorder.


