RESOLUTION NO. 2167

CANCELING ELECTION FOR CHINO VALLEY IRRIGATION DISTRICT AND APPOINTING THE PERSON WHO FILED NOMINATION PETITIONS

WHEREAS, A.R.S. §16-410 provides that if the total of the number of persons who file a nomination petition for a candidate and the number of persons who file a nomination paper for a write-in candidate as prescribed by chapter 3, articles 2 and 3 of this title is less than or equal to the number of positions to be filled at the election for which the nomination petition or nomination paper is filed, the County Board of Supervisors may cancel the election no earlier than one hundred five days before the election and appoint the person or persons who filed the nomination petition or nomination paper to fill the position for the term of office for which the candidate was nominated by the qualified electors; and

WHEREAS, one position on the Board of Directors for the Chino Valley Irrigation District was open for election, and one person filed nomination petitions; and

WHEREAS, the district requested that the Board of Supervisors cancel the election and appoint the person who filed nomination petitions.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the November 4, 2025, election for the Chino Valley Irrigation District is canceled and the following person who filed nomination petitions is appointed:
