**A RESOLUTION OF THE YAVAPAI COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS TO
RESCIND RESOLUTION NO. 2049 REGARDING ROAD ENGINEERING
STANDARDS AND ADDENDUMS THERETO AND TO ADOPT NEW ROAD
ENGINEERING STANDARDS**

WHEREAS, the Yavapai County Board of Supervisors at its December 16, 2020, meeting, adopted Resolution No. 2049 and addenda thereto setting out minimum engineering standards for road construction; and,

WHEREAS, the County Engineer has recommended the standards be updated to reflect current engineering standards as reflected in Attachment A to this Resolution; and

WHEREAS, the Yavapai County Board of Supervisors has determined it is in the best interests to update the minimum engineering standards for road construction within Yavapai County.

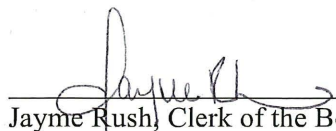
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Yavapai County Board of Supervisors rescinds Resolution No. 2049 and any addenda thereto and adopts the engineering standards set out in Exhibit A as the minimum standards for the design, construction, and paving of all streets and alleys and the installation of private rights of way within Yavapai County.

All roadways conveyed to the public shall require acceptance of the conveyance by the Yavapai County Board of Supervisors. All public roadways shall be constructed to the standards set out in Exhibit A prior to approval for maintenance. Approval for maintenance shall be by written documentation signed by the Yavapai County Board of Supervisors.
