**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF YAVAPAI COUNTY
PERTAINING TO THE SUBMISSION AND ACCEPTANCE OF THE GROOM CREEK
FIRE DISTRICT, AND VERDE VALLEY FIRE DISTRICT HAVING ENTERED
PHASE II OF THE GILA RIVER INDIAN COMMUNITY 2024 GRANTS CYCLE.**

WHEREAS, Yavapai County Board of Supervisors encourages and supports activities that will promote public safety and services to our communities; and

WHEREAS, the Gila River Indian Community Grants Review Committee has completed its review of grant applications for the 2024 grants cycle; and

WHEREAS, the Groom Creek Fire District and Verde Valley Fire District have each prepared and submitted grant applications for consideration of the Gila River Indian Community requesting funds to be used to enhance the services they provide to the public; and

WHEREAS, the Groom Creek Fire District and Verde Valley Fire District are being recommended for approval of funding in Phase II for a total amount of \$112,953.00

1. Groom Creek Fire District – Public Safety Equipment Acquisition. Recommended grant amount of \$49,616.00
2. Verde Valley Fire District – Rural Response Vehicle. Recommended grant amount of \$63,337.00

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Yavapai County Board of Supervisors acknowledge that Phase II of the grant cycle-grant recommendation does not constitute an award; and


