Yavapai County had 65 COVID-19 Cases

There have been **3,539** confirmed cases of COVID-19 and **115** deaths reported in Arizona.

To date, **42,109** Arizonans have been tested for COVID-19. **1,555** residents have been tested in Yavapai County, with **1,490** tests being negative. We have **65** cases in Yavapai County, with two additional cases reported overnight. Verde Valley Medical Center is reporting they have 2 patients hospitalized for COVID-19, and 16 persons under investigation (PUI). YRMC reported on Friday they are looking into adding a dashboard for current info on their website. A PUI is an in-patient who has been admitted for care that has been tested for COVID-19 with results still pending.
