51,045 Arizonans have been tested for COVID-19 with **4,719** positive cases and **177** deaths. **1,931** Yavapai County residents have been tested with 1,859 negative, 72 positive with 5 recoveries, and 1 death. YCCHS has not received data on the additional case ADHS is reporting. VVMC reported 3 hospitalizations from COVID-19, and 14 persons under investigation (PUI) as of 4:30 p.m. yesterday. YRMC reports 3 hospitalizations with COVID-19, with 10 PUIs on West Campus, 3 on the East Campus. The VA reported 1 COVID-19 hospitalization and no PUIs.
