Their online shop will be open Tuesdays at noon through Thursdays at noon weekly. Online orders are first-come, first-served, and there are plenty of food options.

SNAP/EBT Customers: UNLIMITED Double Up Food Bucks are back through May 30th. This means that families can double ANY amount of fresh vegetables purchased to purchase SNAP-eligible foods. To get the most out of your order make sure half of your order is vegetables. Please email info@prescottfarmersmarket.org and ask for the EBT coupon code, then visit the online shop and place your order using the code.

There will be a pop-up food pantry at Prescott Gateway Mall on Sunday, April 26 starting at 9 a.m. Their goal is to distribute 500 boxes of food for families of 4 or 5.
