FDA and CDC Lift the Recommended Pause on Johnson & Johnson COVID-19 Vaccine

Following a thorough safety review, including two meetings of the CDC's Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices, the U.S. Food and Drug Administration and the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention have determined that the recommended pause regarding the use of the Johnson & Johnson (Janssen) COVID-19 Vaccine in the U.S. should be lifted and use of the vaccine should resume. "After recommending a pause out of an abundance of caution, we join our federal partners in encouraging everyone to get vaccinated against COVID-19 with the vaccine available to you," ADHS Director Dr. Cara Christ said. "Arizonans can be confident that all COVID-19 vaccines approved for emergency use, including the Johnson & Johnson vaccine, have undergone a thorough review for safety and efficacy. The federal review will continue on all of the vaccines as more people are vaccinated."

YCCHS is determining the availability of the Johnson & Johnson COVID-19 vaccine remaining in the county to be able to inform the public where appointments may be available. Yavapai County has administered close to 151k doses of COVID-19 vaccine, with 89,199 residents having received at least one dose or 38.4% of the population, and 67,463 people have been fully vaccinated against COVID-19.

First dose appointments are available through the Spectrum Healthcare clinics, YCCHS clinics, and pharmacies. Check the YCCHS website for links to make appointments: https://www.yavapai.us/chs/Home/COVID-19/COVID-19-Vaccine-Appointments.

The Spectrum POD in PV is operating Saturday/Sunday/Mondays and the POD in Cottonwood is operating Wednesday/Thursday/Fridays only offering 2nd doses of the Moderna vaccine. Call Spectrum's Call Center with questions regarding 2nd doses 928-414-8884. YRMC's POD at the old Sears Building is open only for 2nd dose appointments scheduled. For questions relating to second dose appointments, call 928-708-4556.

Yavapai County reports 38 COVID-19 Cases over the Weekend. The county has tested 112,739 residents for COVID-19 with 18,638 positive cases and 500 deaths. Yavapai Regional Medical Center reports 11 COVID-19 patients, VVMC reports 4, and the VA has no COVID-19 patients.
