April 30th Update - Yavapai County Community Health Services **Yavapai County has 81 COVID-19 Cases and 4 Additional Recovered**

71,786 Arizonans have been tested for COVID-19 with **7,648** positive cases and **320** deaths. Yavapai County has tested **2,339** residents, with **2,241** tests negative and **81** positives, **11** recovered, and **2** deaths. The Epidemiologist received an additional case overnight. VVMC reports **1** hospitalization from COVID-19, and **7** persons under investigation (PUI). YRMC reports **2** hospitalizations with COVID-19, with **7** PUIs on West Campus, **2** on the East Campus. The VA reports **no** COVID-19 hospitalizations or PUIs.

Governor Ducey's "Return Stronger" Executive Order extends the Stay Home, Stay Healthy, Stay Connected to 5/15 - The coronavirus is different from anything else this country or this world has dealt with. The coronavirus is still out there and reopening the economy, however right or wrong that decision may be, means a heightened likelihood that it negatively affects us.
