## **YCCHS Update:**

In Yavapai County, health concerns are always present and sometimes a friendly reminder is a good way to help everyone maximize their health and wellness.

- Yavapai County is in the middle of the mosquito season. Many community members see and experience this daily! The **mosquitos aren't carrying serious diseases this season**, but they have in the past.
  - The best prevention is to remove standing water from your residence, use repellents like DEET, citronella candles, and eucalyptus mineral oil.
- Physical and mental wellness are necessary to remain resilient and prepared for other stressors in life. Enhance your wellness with simple, easy steps:
  - Find time to move during your work and interrupt repetitive or stationary activities. Motion is lotion!
  - o Don't delay preventative checks with your doctor, they can catch issues early or confirm that you're right on track.
  - Make time for quality experiences with friends and family. It plays a real role in your health!
- For physical safety, we're in monsoon season so flooding is an active hazard that can suddenly appear. Avoid flood areas whenever possible.
- As a reminder, remain aware of fentanyl's prevalence and deadliness in our community. MATFORCE has accurately stated, "One Pill Can Kill".
