**1,355,757** Arizonans have been tested for COVID-19 with **199,459** positive results and **4,896** deaths. Yavapai County has tested **35,188** residents with **74** new tests reported, **2,264** positive cases, **967** recovered, and **76** deaths. YRMC West is caring for **6** COVID-19 patients, the East campus has **1** and there are **6** persons under investigation (PUI). Verde Valley Medical Center reports **1** COVID-19 hospitalizations and **2** PUIs. The VA has **1** COVID-19 patients with no PUI.
