August 27th Update - Yavapai County Community Health Services Yavapai County reports 6 COVID-19 Cases Today

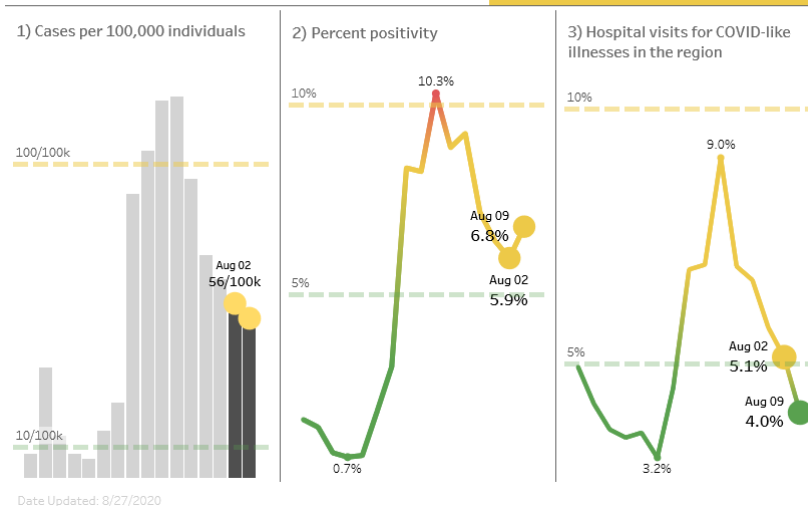

1,436,275 Arizonans have been tested for COVID-19 with 200,139 positive results and 4,929 deaths. Yavapai County has tested 33,612 residents with 274 new tests reported, 2,270 positive cases, 966 recovered, and 76 deaths. YRMC West is caring for 4 COVID-19 patients, the East campus has 2 and there are 5 persons under investigation (PUI). Verde Valley Medical Center reports 2 COVID-19 hospitalizations and 1 PUIs. The VA has 0 COVID-19 patients with no PUI.

Business Reopening Status: **Moderate**



The newest COVID-related metrics have been posted to Arizona Department Of Health Services website, which is helping to navigate re-openings of businesses in Yavapai County.

As of August 9, 2020, Yavapai County is currently in the moderate spread category, based on 51 cases per 100,000 population, 6.8% positivity rate, and 4% Hospital visits for COVID-like illnesses.

Businesses that have been closed due to any of the Governor's Executive Orders must file an attestation form on AZDHS' website to be granted approval for reopening in a moderate spread metric.
