COVID-19 Information

The Arizona Department of Health has up-to-date monitoring of testing and results, information about the virus and prevention/preparation. The link is: https://azdhs.gov/preparedness/epidemiology-disease-epidemiology/index.php#novel-coronavirus-home

The state's focus is to monitor travelers, identify and isolate potential carriers, contact tracing for anyone in contact with those individuals, and testing high suspect cases. Health departments throughout the state are conducting disease surveillance, coordinating with health partners, developing and distributing guidance to schools, law enforcement, cities and towns, implementing preparedness plans and communicating with state, the CDC and the public. The shift nationally now is to slow the spread of the virus, promote social distancing and protect health care providers.
