December 18 Update - Yavapai County reports 176 COVID-19 Cases

ADHS reports **23,138** COVID-19 tests statewide since yesterday with **7,819** positive results and **142** deaths. Yavapai County has cumulatively tested **75,104** residents with **9,150** positive cases, **3,202** recovered, and **172** deaths. Many additional deaths have been reported and are being reviewed to determine if they are COVID-related. YRMC West has **73** COVID-19 patients, YRMC East is caring for **27** patients. VVMC reports **21** COVID-19 hospitalizations. The VA reports **10** COVID-19 patients.

and register with the "Arizona Emergency System for the advance registration of volunteer health professionals. You can select COVID-19 and any other categories you might want to help in.

The Advisory Committee's recommendation paves the way for FDA authorization of the Moderna COVID vaccine. With vaccine arriving in the coming weeks and if your facility wishes to receive vaccine, you need to onboard with ADHS. Onboarding is not an instantaneous process. Both VFC and non-VFC providers who would like to administer future COVID-19 vaccines must complete the Pandemic Provider Onboarding survey forms. It will take AIPO time to add providers to ASIIS and review requirements. Onboard now. Plan for it to take time. There is also training to learn how to order, receive, administer, documents and account for pandemic vaccines in ASIIS.

All providers must use the REDCap onboarding tool:

<https://aipo.myabsorb.com/?KeyName=PandemicProviders>. The tool requires each provider to submit valid credentials. The AIPO team reviews each provider's submission for accuracy and completeness.
