Winter Storms across the Country Delay Shipments of Vaccine

Extreme winter weather impacting much of the country has delayed this week's COVID-19 vaccine shipments to Arizona, the Arizona Department of Health Services said Tuesday night. The delay in COVID-19 vaccine shipments has resulted in some local health departments being forced to cancel appointments over the next two days.

The state health department said it is in regular contact with federal and local partners to monitor the situation. The amount of vaccine ordered statewide is 1,395,300 as of the update on Tuesday, with 79% utilized. Over 1.2 million doses of the coronavirus vaccine have been administered across the state.

The Biden administration said the weather was expected to disrupt shipments from a FedEx facility in Memphis and a UPS installation in Louisville, Kentucky. Both serve as vaccine shipping hubs for a number of states, including Arizona.

Yavapai County is expecting a shipment of 9,400 doses of the Moderna vaccine this week and haven't received any update of when the shipping will resume.

Press releases from both YRMC and Spectrum Healthcare have alerted the public that their points of dispensing (PODs) at Findlay Toyota Events Center, the old Sears at Gateway Mall, and Verde Valley Christian Church need to be canceled today. Vaccine Administration in Yavapai County – According to the ADHS Vaccine Administration Dashboard, Yavapai County has administered 47,893 COVID-19 vaccines with 43,216 first doses, and over 4,850 second doses.

Yavapai County reports 34 COVID-19 Cases and 1 Death

Over 4 million Arizonans have been tested for COVID-19, with over 800,000 positive cases and 15,000 deaths reported statewide. The county has tested 99,091 residents with 17,175 positive cases, 7,133 recovered, and 424 deaths. YRMC is caring for 25 COVID-19 patients, 18 on the West campus, and 7 on the East campus. Verde Valley Medical Center reports 9 COVID patients and the VA reports no patients.
