### **YCCHS Update:**

On July 25<sup>th</sup> and 26<sup>th</sup> the Yavapai County Community Health Services hosted the Youth Mental Health Conference at the Prescott Resort. Several licensed psychologists and psychoanalysts, community health educators, and members of the community participated in the event. Each day saw many topics being covered in seminars that provided awareness, resource identification, and networking opportunities. The seminars ranged from the keynote topics of **Core Concepts on Trauma, Neurodevelopment and Stress, Let's Talk About Anxiety, Finally!, Resilience and Building Healthy Relationships** to subtopics like The Art of De-escalation and Historical Trauma. In attendance were more than 240 community members over both days, and several youths aged 14-18 who participated by sharing their input and life experiences directly with those in attendance. YCCHS personnel hope to continue this event annually and to recruit more talent and knowledge from the mental health community in order to better serve the youth of Yavapai County.

Yavapai County reports 440 COVID-19 Cases and 6 Deaths since Wednesday, July 20<sup>th</sup>, 2022. There have been 52,980 positive cases and 1,260 deaths since the beginning of the pandemic.
