May 18th Update - Yavapai County Community Health Services Yavapai County reports 266 COVID-19 Cases

212,784 Arizonans have been tested by COVID-19, with 14,170 positive cases and 686 deaths. Yavapai County has tested 7,695 residents, with 266 positive cases, 38 recovered, and 5 deaths. Yavapai Regional Medical Center reports 3 hospitalizations with COVID-19 with 1 person under investigation (PUI) on the West Campus. Verde Valley Medical Center reports no hospitalizations with COVID and 4 PUIs as of yesterday afternoon. The VA has reported no hospitalizations or PUIs for COVID-19, however 8 out of 10 Veterans and 3 staff have recovered as outpatients over the timeframe of the pandemic.
