Yavapai County reports 283 COVID-19 Cases and 7 Deaths since Friday, November 5, 2021. The county has tested 97,221 residents for COVID-19 in the past 6 months, and there have been 29,487 positive cases and 715 deaths since the beginning of the pandemic. Yavapai Regional Medical Center reports 61 COVID-patients, VVMC reports 28 patients, and the VA has 5 COVID-19 patients. The County is still experiencing high transmission of COVID-19 with a 16.6% positivity rate and 267 cases per 100,000 residents for the week ending October 24, 2021.
