Yavapai County reports 17 COVID-19 Cases

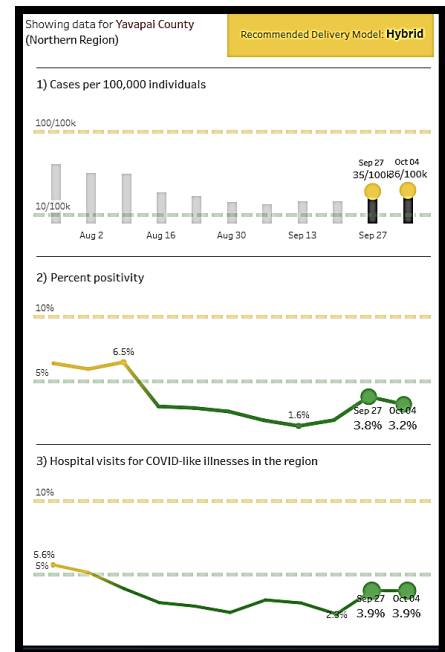

1,979,581 Arizonans have been tested for COVID-19 with **234,906** positive results and **5,859** deaths. Yavapai County has tested **48,223** residents with **2,846** positive cases, **1,524** recovered, and **87** deaths. YRMC West is caring for **5** COVID-19 patients with **2** persons under investigation (PUI), the East campus has **3** COVID-19 patients and **4** PUIs. Verde Valley Medical Center reports **2** COVID-19 hospitalizations and **no** PUIs. The VA reports **no** COVID-19 patients.

ADHS Updated the School and Business Reopening Dashboards today - Yavapai County's status as of October 4th is still moderate, with cases per 100,000 at 36, a 3.2% positivity rate, and 3.9% of hospital visits having COVID-like illness. Community and business partners, working together with local health departments, have an important role in slowing the spread of diseases in Arizona. The actions you take make a difference.

1. Adhere to safety measures – wear a mask in public places, maintain 6' distances and heightened sanitations efforts.
2. Think about the health risks to others. Stay home if you aren't well. If you are exposed to someone who has tested positive for COVID-19, get tested.
3. Take care of yourself. COVID-19 "fatigue" has been a depleting, draining experience. Think about exercising safely, eating properly, setting achievable goals, so you feel emotionally and physically stronger.
4. Seek joy in unexpected places.
