1,553,079 Arizonans have been tested for COVID-19 with **207,523** positive results and **5,288** deaths. Yavapai County has tested **38,315** residents with a total of **2,401** positive cases, **1,100** recovered, and **79** deaths. YRMC West is caring for **7** COVID-19 patients, the East campus has **no** COVID-19 patients and there are **no** persons under investigation (PUI). Verde Valley Medical Center reports **2** COVID-19 hospitalizations and **5** PUIs. The VA has **no** COVID-19 patients or PUIs.
