1,541,471 Arizonans have been tested for COVID-19 with **206,541** positive results and **5,251** deaths. Yavapai County has tested **37,944** residents with a total of **2,373** positive cases, **1,082** recovered, and **79** deaths. YRMC West is caring for **11** COVID-19 patients and **5** persons under investigation, the East campus has **no** COVID-19 patients and **2** persons under investigation (PUI). Verde Valley Medical Center reports **2** COVID-19 hospitalizations and **3** PUIs. The VA has **1** COVID-19 patient, and **no** PUIs.

COVID-19 Vaccine Update - Nine vaccine makers say they have signed a joint pledge to uphold "high ethical standards," suggesting they won't seek premature government approval for any Covid-19 vaccines they develop.

"We, the undersigned biopharmaceutical companies, want to make clear our on-going commitment to developing and testing potential vaccines for COVID-19 in accordance with high ethical standards and sound scientific principles," the pledge, released Tuesday, reads.

The companies that signed the pledge include AstraZeneca, BioNTech, Moderna, Pfizer, Novavax, Sanofi, GlaxoSmithKline, Johnson & Johnson and Merck. These companies wrote that they pledge to "Only submit for approval or emergency use authorization after demonstrating safety and efficacy through a Phase 3 clinical study that is designed and conducted to meet requirements of expert regulatory authorities such as FDA." The nine vaccine makers said they will stand with science, at a time when the world is looking to science -- to develop the vaccine -- to help bring us to the end of the pandemic.
