81,119 Arizonans have been tested for COVID-19 with **8,640** positive cases and **362** deaths. Yavapai County has tested **2,482** residents, with **2,391** tests negative and **91** positives, **11** recovered, and **2** deaths. Two additional cases came in overnight to the YCCHS Epidemiologist. VVMC reports **1** hospitalization from COVID-19, and **3** persons under investigation (PUI) as of yesterday afternoon. YRMC reports **2** hospitalizations with COVID-19, with **4** PUIs on West Campus, **4** on the East Campus. The VA has **no** COVID-19 hospitalizations or PUIs.
