Municipal Data Gaps

The TWG discussed the significance of shifting from municipal boundaries to planning area boundaries. We also need to be very careful not to double account for areas.

CDPs and CCDs

The TWG discussed the methods for calculating water usage and making projections in the CCDs.

Action Item: John will coordinate with Chip and Carol to develop a methodology.

General Discussion

GPCD Definitions

There has been some concern about using uniform assumptions for the study. We discussed the use of GPCD and the development of meaningful projections. The CYHWRMS Plan of Study states that "demands should include: Municipal, Industrial, Agriculture, Ecological, Recreational, Tribal, Energy, and others." Doug suggested that maybe we should put together a calculator which allows each community to calculate domestic water use with gpcd and then add lump sums for other uses as appropriate.

Action Item: Doug will develop demand calculator for review and discussion by the TWG.

Population Assumptions

Based on the same "uniform assumption" discussion, the TWG addressed population data.

Action Item: Leslie M. will add DES information to Demand Table for comparison purposes.
