

Court Services

The purpose of this program is to provide the most efficient probation services to the community, Courts, and probation staff members. Court Services staff work as a liaison between probation officers and other court departments, which improves communication and assists the Court and the probation department in resolving probation matters promptly. Generally, Court Services staff handle most Court hearings for field probation officers, thereby reducing the time that probation officers spend in court. As a result, community safety is enhanced, by allowing probation officers to spend more time in the community checking on the compliance of probationers and working to change behaviors of probationers to reduce future criminal activity. Court Services staff handle all matters pertaining to the Early Disposition Court and Probation Violation Hearings.
