

EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT

Yavapai County Office of Emergency Management principle responsibility is supporting the safety of our citizens and visitors, protection of our infrastructure, as well as the environment. This is accomplished through a proactive, comprehensive, and integrated planning and coordination process to enhance response to an incident. Furthermore, focus is given to mitigation of hazards, response to incidents, recovery from incidents, and preparedness through planning, training, and exercise development. The goal is to build a disaster resilient community, capable of responding to and recovering from any incident.

Much of our work is in the area of mitigation (lessening the effect) of hazards. Yavapai County Office of Emergency Management sponsors and supports grant funded projects for the development of defensible space through wildland fire hazardous fuel mitigation. AIRPORTS

Yavapai County owns three general aviation public use airports located at Bagdad, Sedona, and Seligman. The Sedona Airport is operated and maintained by the Sedona Oak Creek Airport Authority. (SOCAA) through a lease agreement, and the Bagdad and Seligman airports are operated and maintained by the Public Works Department.

Airport design and construction projects are funded by the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) and the Arizona Department of Transportation-Aeronautics Division (ADOT) grants and local matches.

PERMITTING

Public Works issues several types of permits in accordance with Yavapai County Ordinance 2020-5.

ROADS

The Roads Division provides for the maintenance of county road systems; approx. 800 miles of paved and 800 miles of unpaved roads for a total of approx. 1600 miles.

Local Roads are funded by the Highway User Revenue Fund (HURF); gas tax and vehicle license fees.

Regional Roads are funded by a portion of the half cent sales tax.

- Engineering and Pavement Management

- Hauling materials and grading dirt roads
- Cleaning roadside ditches and culverts
- Snowplowing

- Street signs and road striping
- Inspections and Permitting
- Right of Way
