Dear Yavapai County Resident / Property Owner:

The street / easement adjacent to your property has been officially named, in cooperation with you, your neighbors, and Yavapai County. As part of working with you to name this private street, Yavapai County requires street name signs be installed in accordance with the Yavapai County Street Name Sign Standards for private streets, which is a reflective brown background and reflective white lettering. The standard is a specific size, shape, and coloring, please see attached standards. Yavapai County encourages sign and installation costs be shared among the neighbors, and not by any single individual.

The Local Fire Department, Yavapai County Sheriff's Office, and Utility Agencies depend on street signs and address numbers to be properly displayed in order to locate you and your property during an emergency or non-emergency situation. The street sign should be clearly visible and reflective both day and night.

Listed below are some local businesses that specialize in making and installing street signs. You are welcome to use any sign company or create the sign yourself, so long as the street sign meets the specifications and standards for private street signs. Please be aware that you must call Arizona 811 (formerly known as Blue Stake) before installing the post for the street signs. AZ811 is a free but required service and they will need to mark the utilities before you dig. The phone number for AZ811 is 811 or 1-800-STAKE-IT (1-800-782-5348). To order a street sign(s) or request installation of a street sign, please contact the sign company directly.

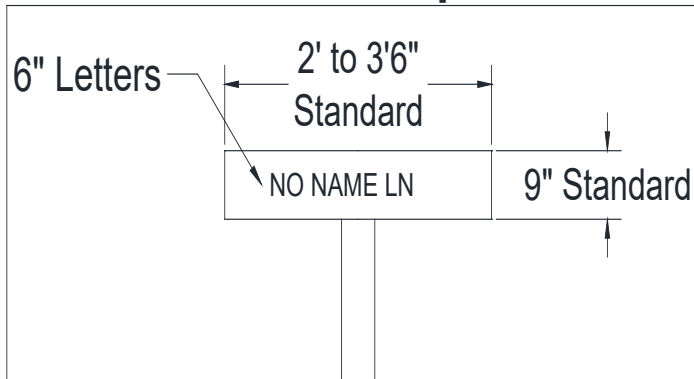

1. Street name signs are required to have a brown high-intensity reflective background with white reflective lettering.
2. Sign posts, foundations, and mountings shall be constructed as to hold signs in a proper and permanent position, and to resist swaying in the wind or displacement by vandalism. (Break away posts are recommended in case of sign post damage).
3. Signs should be vertically mounted at right angles to the direction of, and facing, the traffic they are intended to serve. Signs should be placed on top of existing posts or stop signs when available.
4. It will be the responsibility of the property owners to keep the sign properly positioned, clean, and legible with adequate reflectivity. Damage or deteriorated signs should be immediately replaced by the property owners.
