



Correctional Officers Retirement Plan (CORP)

Authority: A.R.S §38-893 and Yavapai County Resolution No. 1647

Membership: Five members plus a non-voting secretary. Two members are employees of the Sheriff's Office, elected by secret ballot by members employed by the Sheriff's Office and two citizens (public), one of whom shall be the head of the Merit System, if it exists, who are appointed by the Chair of the Board of Supervisors with the approval of the Board of Supervisors. The current Chair of the Board of Supervisors or her designee serves as the Chairman.

Term of Office: four years, staggered

General Duties: Oversight for administering the County's Correctional Officers Retirement Plan. Decide all questions of eligibility and service credits, and determine the amount, manner, and time of payment of any benefit under the plan.
